FOR PARENTS

Teach your child his address and telephone number as early as possible.

ldentify with your child all the adults that can accompany him during outings.

Write your phone numbers (mobile, home, office) on a piece of paper and slide it inside your child's pocket or jacket.

Explain to your child the importance of always staying within eyesight when in public places.

Teach your child the importance of always relying on their internal alarm (their intuition) and know whether they feel okay or not "inside".




